Sažetak izlaganja: This lecture will present results of the anthropological research among Mapuche aboriginal people from the northern Patagonian provinces of Rio Negro and Neuquen in southern Argentina. The main goal of the research was to gather information about Mapuche ethnic and political revival, which began after the end of the last military dictatorship in December 1983. The changes of policies dealing with the rights of indigenous people, which have occurred during the last 30 years, are discussed in the context of state and regional political and economic transformations, and activities of Mapuche indigenous organizations.

Juan Carlos Radovich was born in Buenos Aires, Argentina within a family of Croatian origin. He is a researcher and Professor at the University of Buenos Aires from 1984, and a Senior Research Fellow at the National Council for Scientific and Technological Research (CONICET). He is also the co-director of the Program "Ethnicities and Territories in Redefinition" at the Institute of Anthropological Sciences at the same University. His research interests are: rural anthropology; applied anthropology; social impact of tourism on indigenous populations; big dams social impacts; population resettlements; social effects of oil and gas production; rural-urban migration; indigenous policies; indigenous political movements in Argentina; ethnic conflicts in modern world; racism and discrimination in contemporary society. He was a visiting researcher and professor at several universities and research centers in Australia, Brasil, Chile, Colombia and Slovenia. Some of his publications in English are: "Effects of Megaprojects on an Indigenous Reserve in North Patagonia, Argentina" (Bulletin IUAES, Viena, 1996); "Forced Resettlement Process among Mapuche population in Northern Patagonia" (Yumtzilob, Rotterdam, 1999); "Present Situation of Indigenous Peoples in Argentina" (Culturlink-IMO, Zagreb, 1999); "Mapuche handicrafts trading: Production of sense and socio-cultural reproduction" (Suvremene teme, Centar za politološka istraživanja, Zagreb, 2010).
